**Historical Summary:** Coxwell & O'Connor Dump Former truck garden, became a garbage dump and then built over (Andy Gilmour pc 29.6.94). Harold Cooper says that there was a gully here which was filled with incinerator ash. The truck garden located here and between Woodbine, Coxwell, Plains and O'Connor was covered with incinerator ash (Andy Gilmour, interview, August 1994).
